5-2-95 MOL and RU. Spud surface hole at 1145 hrs 5/1/95 with spud mud and bit #1 (12-1/4", HTC, OSC). TD surface hole at 281'. Ran 7 jts. (261.74') of 9-5/8", 36# and 40#, K-55, ST&C and LT&C casing and set at 273' KB. Cementers Inc. cemented with 135 sx. (161 cu.ft.) of CI "B" with 3% CaCl2 and 1/4# cello flake/sk. Displaced plug with 19 bbls of water. Plug down at 1830 hrs 5/1/95. Circulated 10 bbls of cement to surface.

5-3-95 Pressure test BOP & 7" casing to 1500#, held OK.

5-5-95 TD'd 8-3/4" hole at 3485'. Schlumberger ran IND/GR CDL/CNL logs. Loggers TD @ 3480'.

5-6-95 Ran 78 jts (3504.86') of 7", 20#, K-55, ST&C casing and landed @ 3485' KB. Float collar @ 3457'. BJ cemented with 405 sx (830 cu.ft.) of class "B" with 2% CaCl2, 8% gel, and 1/4# cello-flake/sk. Tailed with 160 sx (189 cu.ft.) of class "B" with 2% CaCl2 and 1/4# cello-flake/sk. Preceded cement with 30 Bbls of gel water and 20 bbls of scavenger cement. Pressure test BOP and casing to 1500#, held OK. Unload hole with nitrogen, dry hole.

5-8-95 TD'd 6-1/4" hole with gas and bit #4 (6-1/4", HTC, J-33). Schlumberger ran IND/GR, CDL/SNL and temperature logs. Ran 58 jts (2585.10' of 4-1/2", 10.5#, K-55, ST&C casing and landed @ 5920' KB. Float collar @ 5876'. Top of liner hanger @ 3326'. BJ cemented with 245 sx (424 cu.ft.) of class "B" with 4% gel, 6-1/4# gilsonite/sk, and CF14 (fluid loss). Preceded cement with 20 bbls of gel water. Displaced cement with 65 bbls of water and plug down at 0215 hours 5-8-95. Rig released @ 0600 hours 5-8-95.
