6-30-95 MOL and RU. Spud surface hole at 1630 hrs 6-29-95. TD'd surface hole with spud mud and bit #1 (13-3/4", HTC, OSC3 RR) @ 337'. Ran 7 jts (319.33') of 10-3/4", 32.75#, H-40, ST&C casing and set @ 333' KB. Cemented with 225 sx (266 cu.ft.) of class "B" with 3% CaCl2 and 1/4# cello-flake/sk. Displaced plug with 30 bbls and down at 0215 hrs 6-30-95. Circulated 9 bbls of cement to surface.

7-01-95 PT to 1500#, OK.

7-03-95 TD'd intermediate hole @ 3700' with bit #2 (9-7/8", HTC, 11H).

7-04-95 SWS ran IND/GR & CDL/CNL logs. LDDP. Ran 84 jts (3689.16') of 7-5/8", 36.4#, K-55, ST&C casing and landed at 3701' KB. Float collar at 3655'. BJ cemented with 611 sx (1253 cu.ft.) of class "B" 65/35 poz with 2% CaCl2, 8% gel, and 1/4# cello-flake/sk. Tailed with 250 sx (295 cu.ft.) of class "B" with 2% CaCl2 and 1/4# cello-flake/sk. Preceded cement with 30 bbls of gel water and 20 bbls of scavenger cement. Displaced cement with 170 bbls of water and plug down at 0230 hrs on 7-4-95. Circulate 10 bbls of cement to surface.

7-05-95 Pressure test 7-5/8" casing and BOP to 1500#, held OK. Unload and dry hole with nitrogen. Well dusting at 1715 hrs 7-04-95.

7-09-95 TD well at 8157' bit #5 (6-3/4", HTC, J55).

7-10-95 Finished running IES/GR, SNL/CDL & temp logs across Mesaverde.

7-11-95 TD well at 8175'. SWS ran IES/GR & SNL/CDL across Dakota.

7-12-95 Ran 81 jts 5-1/2" casing.

7-13-95 Cemented with 225 sx (300 cu.ft.) of CL "B" 50/50 Poz, with 4% gel, 1/4# Cello-flake/sk & 0.5% CF14(fluid loss). Tailed w/ 100 sx (118 cu.ft.) of CL "B" w/ 2% CaCl2 & 1/4# Cello-flake/sk. Displaced cement with 70 bbls of water and 70 bbls of mud. Drop dart & establish circ. through DV collar w/ 2900#. Circ. out gel water & 8 bbls of cement from 1st stage. Cemented with 305 sx (412 cu.ft.) of CL "B" 50/50 Poz, with 4% gel, 1/4# Cello-flake/sk & 0.5% CF14(fluid loss). Displaced plug with 75 bbls. Plug down at 0200 hrs 7/13/95. Circulate 12 bbls of cement. Rig released at 0600 hrs 7/13/95. Casing shoe at 6155' KB. Float collar at 6131' KB, top of marker joint at 5666' KB, DV tool at 3295'.
