Subject well spudded 10-24-65. Set 10 3/4" surface casing at 204' and cemented same with 150 sacks. Plug down at 2:30 A.M. 10-25-65. Ran electric log at 3772'. Cemented 7 5/8" intermediate casing at 3772' with 200 sacks. On November 11, 1965, encountered 1" of water flow at 3945' while drilling a 6 3/4" hole with gas. Went in hole with open end drill pipe and spotted 100 sacks of cement on bottom. Pulled drill pipe above cement, pumped down casing and pumped cement into formation with no pressure. Went in hole with bit, found top of cement at 3922'. Went in hole with open end drill pipe and spotted 100 sacks of cement on bottom at 3922'. Pulled pipe above cement and pumped down casing. Pumped 65 sacks of cement in formation. Maximum pressure 1500 psi.

Ran drill pipe with 6 3/4" bit. Drilled out cement from 3920-3945'. Blowing hole in an attempt to dry and drill with gas. Drilled to 4,000'. Unable to dry hole. Squeeze cemented open hole from 3790' to 4,000' with 125 sacks. Maximum pressure 3000 psi. Total depth of 8330' reached 12-30-65. Cemented 5 1/2" casing at 8195' with 150 sacks. Set cast iron bridge plug at 8190'. Perforated at 8188' with 2 holes per foot. Perforated at 8166 to 8178' with 4 holes per foot.

Presently shut-down due to weather.

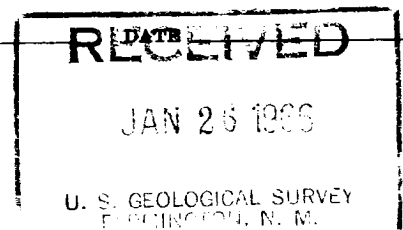
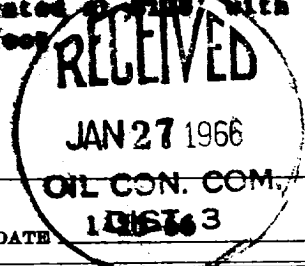

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
