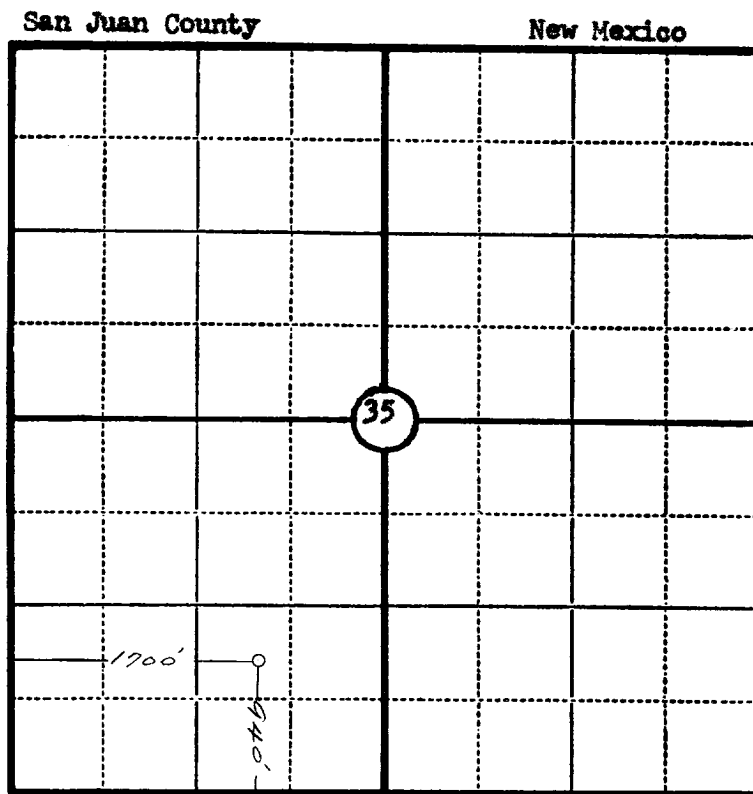


Company Stanolind Oil & Gas Company
