DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was drilled to a total depth of 4670 feet with rotary tools. Shot formation from 3900 to 4670 feet open with 1840 quarts Hercules slow detonating explosive. Well was cleaned out to total depth with gas and 2" tubing landed at 4658 feet. Well shut in 8 days. Shut in casing pressure 1094 psi. After 6 hour blow down well measured 5400 MCF per 24 hours through 2" outlet with pitot tube April 6, 1953.
