Dear Mr. Arnold:

Pubco Russell #2, a Pictured Cliff well in a non-prorated area in Section 33, T30N-R14W, was originally rescheduled for Deliverability test with conditioning period November 8th to November 22nd, test chart week from November 22nd to 30th. The well was shut in on November 18th for revision to the flow line by El Paso.

We are not going to be able to secure a test prior to January 1, 1958. El Paso has been requested to reschedule the well for test as soon as possible. There was no production from Russell #2 during July and August, 1957. It produced 23 days in September and 23 days in October.

The Deliverability will be submitted as soon as it can be scheduled, tested and calculated. We would like assurance from your office that the well will not be shut in due to our failure to submit the C 122-A, which has been due to circumstances behind our control.
