Perforated 6468-6512 and 6522-30 with 2 bullets and 2 jets per foot. Fraced with 143,333 gallons of fluid-loss, gelled treated water and 120,000 pounds 20-40 sand. Breakdown was 1800 psig, average treating pressures was 2200 psig; average injection rate was 45.1 BPM; dropped 40 balls.

Instant shutin was 1400 psig.

Ran 208 joints of CFAI, 2 3/8" NUE, 4.74 tubing to 6507 KB.
