DETAILS OF WORK

1. Well was spudded on July 30, 1959.
2. Ran 1 jt. 18", I-42, conductor casing on July 30, 1959. Pipe landed at 28.50' R.K.B. Cmtd. w/25 sx regular cement with 2% calcium chloride. Pressured up 8500 psi on July 31, 1959 - Pressure held.
3. Ran 9 jts. 10-3/4", 32.75#, H-40 surface casing on August 1, 1959. Pipe landed @ 283.54' R.K.B. Cmtd. w/141 sx regular cement w/2% calcium chloride.
4. Pressured up on surface casing to 800 psi on August 2, 1959. Pressure held.
