Based on observed data, the subject well has a casing leak. As a result, we propose the following:

1. Pull tubing.
2. Set bridge plug at 3550' in top of liner.
3. Isolate casing leak and squeeze with Type "C" cement and attempt to circulate to surface.
4. Drill out cement and set 5" - 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " liner to top of existing liner at 3483' and cement with 260 sz Type "C" cement.
5. Drill, clean out, and test liner. Drill bridge plug, re-run tubing and put well on test.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or may be obtained from the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian lands should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports on abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; date of any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
