DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on November 16, 1959 and drilled to 209'. 8-5/8" casing was set at 209' with 160 sacks cement containing 25 calcium chloride. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 400 psi for thirty minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 209' and resumed drilling operations.
