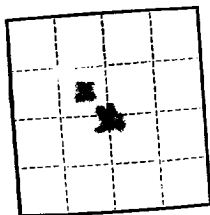

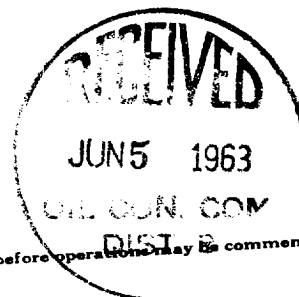

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled to TD of 4460' 5-11-63 and ran Induction-Electric log from 4460' to 157'.
Ran 139 jts. 4-1/2" 11.64/lb J-55 csg to 4458' and cut w/175 an Inner Class "C"
w/125 Oilconite and 50 an Inner Class "C" next around bottom of csg. 100 ft hrs.
Ran tubing to TD and circulated water out with oil. Tested csg to 2000 psi for
30 min. Held OK. Preparing to perforate and sand-oil from the Lower Gallup
interval in two stages.
