On 7-18-67 cut stuck tubing at 4250', pulled tubing.

On 7-19-67 set cement retainer at 4010', squeezed open hole w/200 sacks cement. Dumped 1 bbl. cement on top of retainer. Perf. 3 squeeze holes at 1460', set cement retainer at 1392', squeezed thru perfs into 7" annulus w/250 sacks cement. W.O.C. 12 hours.

On 7-23-67 Total depth 4980'. Ran 157 joints 4 1/2", 10.5#, J-25 casing (4970') set at 4980' w/15 sacks cement. W.O.C. 18 hours.

On 7-25-67 F.B.T.D. 4936', tested casing to 4000' O. K. Perf. Joint lookout 4800-20', 4830-34', 4859-63', 4884-92', 4906-10' w/16 SPZ. Frac w/55,000# 20/40 sand, 56,700 gal. water. Max. pr. 4000#, BDP 2000#, tr. pr. 2000-2100-2300#. I.R. 58.7 BPM. Dropped 4 sets of 16 balls and 1 set of 32, flushed w/3696 gallons of water. ISIP -0-. Set bridge plug at 4700', tested w/4000#. Perf. Cliff House 4186-94', 4199-4207', 4237-45', 4255-63', 4314-22', 4330.5 - 38.5' w/16 SPZ, frac w/48,000# 20/40 sand, 48,720 gallons of water. Max. pr. 4000#, BDP 2600#, tr. pr. 3200-3600-4000#. I.R. 31 BPM. Dropped 5 sets of 16 balls each, flushed w/2553 gallons of water. ISIP 1100#, 5 Min. 400#.
