Dear Donna:

The 1994 Packer Leakage tests on the referenced wells were inconclusive. Reschedule and retest the wells in such a manner as to prove zone separation. Shut both zones in for a minimum of 3 days. Flow the higher pressured zone to the atmosphere until the pressure decreases enough to determine if there is zone separation. Notify this office at least 24 hours prior to the tests so we may provide a witness. The tests must be conducted prior to January 1, 1995.
