Gentlemen:

We refer you to rules 1106 and 1108 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations, found on pages 44 and 48 of the Revised (12-1-59) Rules and Regulations.

Rule 1106 states that Form C-103 must be filed with 10 days following completion of such operations as commencement of drilling, casing tests, shooting, fluid fracturing or chemical treatment, or any other operation affecting the status of the well. Rule 1108 states that Form C-105, Well Record, must be filed within 20 days after the completion of any well. This information can be kept confidential for 90 days after completion of the well at the request of the operator.

Will you please comply with the above regulations immediately.
