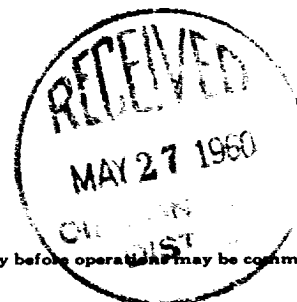

DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 1870' plus back depth 1833'. Set 5-1/2" casing at 1867' with 80 sacks 6 percent gel cement with 1-1/2 pounds tuf plug per sack followed by 50 sacks neat cement. Received good circulation throughout. Displaced mud with oil and spotted 250 gallons 20% across Ballup. Tested casing with 3,000 psi which held with no indication of pressure drop. Released rig May 23, 1960.
