DETAILS OF WORK

O. J. Hoover "B" Well No. 2-I. On November 30, 1958, spotted 200 gallons mud clean out acid on bottom. Perforated Gallup source with two shots per foot 1776-1818, 1890-1918, sand-oil fracked with 39,000 gallons oil and 40,000 pounds sand. Formation broke at 1250 pounds pressure. Treating pressure 1750 pounds, average injection rate 36 barrels per minute. Injected total 40 perforated ball sealers in four stages during run for selective treatment. 2" tubing landed at 1915'. Well is currently being tested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
