Gentlemen:

The above well was formerly a producing gas well from the Pictured Cliffs formation. It was disconnected in May, 1965, and has been temporarily abandoned since that date.

We feel that sufficient time has elapsed for a decision to have been made to either plug and abandon the well in conformance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rules and regulations or to attempt to work the well over and put it on production.

We are therefore directing that action be taken within the next sixty days to either plug this well or work it over.

Form C-103 should be filed with this office setting out work-over or plugging plans prior to commencing work.
