E. Thurland No. 2 was spudded on May 7, 1958 and on May 8, 1958, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 251' with 144 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement for 24 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 500 pounds pressure for 15 minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
