DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill to the top of the Lower-Gallup with rotary tools using mud circulation. 5-1/2" casing will be set with a two stage collar set below the Point Lookout for circulation of cement.

It is then intended to drill into the Lower-Gallup using cable tools. A 4-1/2" slotted liner will be run following sandoil fracturing of the open-hole interval.

Estimated Total Depth 3310'.

Casing Program:

10-3/4" at 120' with 125 sacks cement circulated to surface.

5-1/2" at 3200' with 150 sacks cement - 1st stage; 50 sacks cement - 2nd stage.

4-1/2" liner at 3310' not cemented.

NE SW/4 of Sec. 5 is dedicated to this well. NE SW/4 Sec. 5 SF 080212

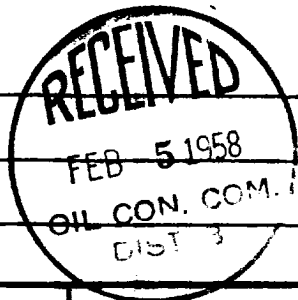

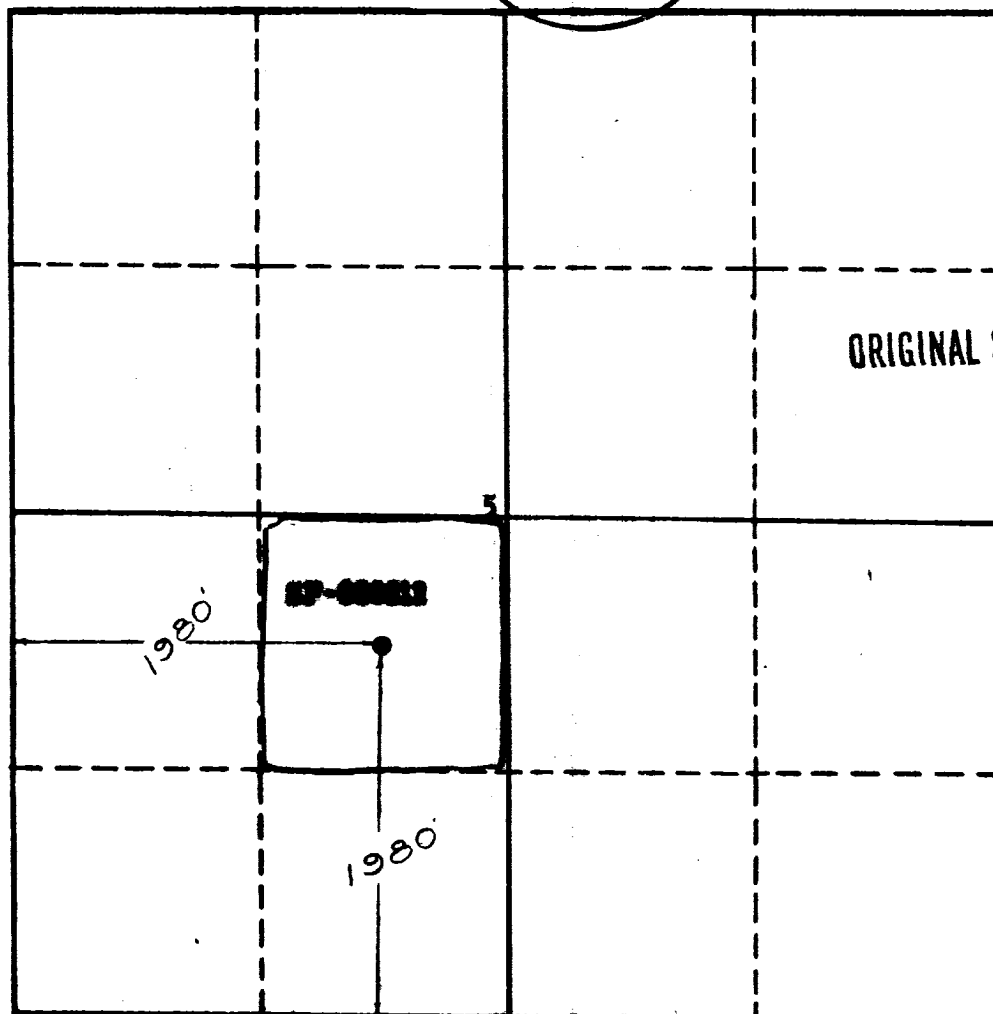
