Set Baker Retainer at 4715' and treated Cliff House formation with 15,700 gallons #2 diesel oil and 26000 sand. Breakdown pressure 1600#, maximum pressure 1700#. Injection rate 252 gallons per minute. Flushed with 2500 gallons oil. Natural gas 162 MCF. Gage 14 hours after treatment 1,646 MCF.
