DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Spudded hole on 8-24-54.

On 8-25-54 we set 119' of 10" - 32.75 lb. casing on bottom of 13" hole and cemented with 125 sacks regular cement. Cement circulated to bottom of cellar.

On 8-26-54 we tested casing with 650 # pressure for 30 minutes. It held pressure O.K. We drilled out cement and shoe and retested with 650 # for 30 minutes and it still held pressure O.K.
