Reference is made to your letter of November 30, 1960 in which you inquired about a well located in the NW¹/₄ Section 4, Township 30N, Range 14W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Our records show a well was completed in this quarter-section on October 27, 1959, with initial potential given as 25 BOPD. However the well was subsequently plugged and abandoned June 28, 1960. We do not have any record of production, but if there was production prior to the plugging of the well this information could be obtained from the operator of record, Mr. Albert C. Bruce, Box 953, Midland, Texas. You would also have to contact the lessor for information in regard to royalties.
