We are writing in regard to King Oil Company #1-A Navajo well, located 2310° from the South Line and 2310° from the West Line of Section 4-30N-17W. This well was recently completed by your company as a gas well in the Gallup Formation. The well was staked and approved as an eil well location on standard 40-acre spacing. Our rules require that a gas well be located a minimum of 79GE from the boundary lines of the tract on which it is located (quarter-section).

This well is therefore a non-standard gas well location and Form C-110 cannot be approved on this well until this matter has been brought to hearing before the Commission for approval of the non-standard location. A corrected Form C-128 should also be filed showing a 160-acre acreage dedication.

We have also been notified by the Southern Union Gas Company that this well was tied in to their system on December 14, 1957. Pending action on the above matters we are as of this date notifying the pipeline company that this well should be shut in until further notice from this office.

Application for hearing should be made to Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr., Box 871, Santa Fe, New Maxico. Exception should be asked to Rule 104, Paragraph B, sub-paragraph (2). This rule is found on Page 11 of the General Rules and Regulations, a copy of which we are enclosing. If we can be of service in the matter, Please let us know.
