2. Cleaned out to 6103' R.K.B. - Pressured up to 1200 psi on 5 1/2" liner for 30 mins. on Aug. 3, 1959 - Pressure held.
3. Perforated 4 shots/ft. 5970-5980; 6084-6096; 2 shots/ft. 5826-5896 5910-5920.
4. Frac. Point Lookout w/100,000# sand & 70,644 gals. water on Aug. 4, 1959.
5. Set Guiberson 5 1/2" magnesium bridge plug at 5810'.
6. Perf 2 shots/ft. from 5472-5514; 5594-5624; 5692-5706; 5712-5728.
7. Frac Cliff House w/87,000# sand & 94,080 gals. water on Aug. 4, 1959.
8. Drilled plug & cleaned out to 6103' R.K.B.
9. Ran 186 jts. 2-3/8", 4.7#, J-55 tbg. on Aug. 6, 1959-Tubing landed at 5837' R.K.B.
