Anclosed is a copy of our Order No. R-128-D which you requested.

dince talking to you the other day I have checked out the dedicated unit for the EPNG No. 1-39 Unit in Section 18-T31N-R9W. You are correct in stating that El Paso originally dedicated the W/2, Section 18, and the SW/4 of Section 7, to this well - a total of 309 acres. Their well was prorated on this basis, with a .97 acreage factor from March 1, 1955, until December 1, 1955. On November 1, 1955, they submitted a new plat showing acreage dedication of the W/2 of Section 18 only. This cut their acreage to 205.8 acres. It therefore appears that 104 acres belonging to you was dedicated to their well for an eight month period.

I talked to Mr. Mankin yesterday and he informed me that administrative approval had been granted for your non-standard unit, consisting of the M/2 of Section 7. You will be receiving a copy of the approval. If we can be of any further service in this matter, please advise.
