WELLS IN SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, SHOULD
NOT BE PLUGGED AND ABANDONED IN ACCORDANCE
WITH A COMMISSION-APPROVED PLUGGING PROGRAM.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on July 6, 1977,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 19th day of July, 1977, the Commission, a
quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record,
and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised
in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the
subject matter thereof.
- (2) That John J. Moya is the owner and operator of the
Hubbard Well No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 4 and the Goode
Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 18, both in Township 30
North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York is the
surety on the Oil Conservation Commission plugging bond on which
John J. Moya is principal.
- (4) That the purpose of said bond is to assure the state
that the subject wells will be properly plugged and abandoned
when not capable of commercial production.
- (5) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative
rights said Hubbard Well No. 1 and Goode Well No. 1 should be
plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by
the Aztec District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation
Commission on or before September 15, 1977, or the well should
be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

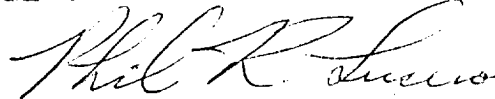
(1) That John J. Moya and Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York are hereby ordered to plug and abandon the Hubbard Well No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 4 and the Goode Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 18, both in Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, on or before September 15, 1977.

(2) That John J. Moya and Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York, prior to plugging and abandoning each of the above-described wells, shall obtain from the Aztec office of the Commission, a Commission-approved program for said plugging and abandoning the well, and shall notify said Aztec office of the date and hour said work is to be commenced whereupon the Commission may, at its option, witness such work.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

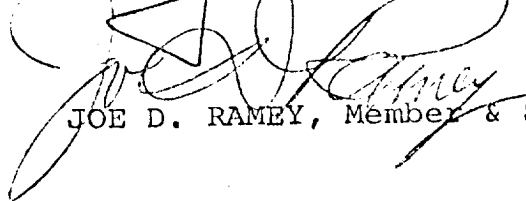
