1. Drilled 9-7/8" hole with sand to T.D. of 3075 ft. R.K.B. Ran I.E.S. log.
2. Ran 78 jts. of 7", 23.0% Intermediate casing. Landed at 3075 ft. R.K.B. Cemented casing with 306 sacks cement. Plug down at 10:00 A.M., 5/21/75.
3. Drilled 6-1/4" hole, with gas to T.D. of 5400 ft. R.K.B. Reached T.D. on 5/23/75.
4. Ran Density and Temperature logs.
5. Ran 75 joints of 4-1/2", 10.5%, H-40 casing as a liner. Top of liner at 5397 ft. R.K.B. Bottom of liner at 5397 ft. R.K.B. Cemented liner w/386 sacks of cement. Plug down at 9:20 A.M., 5/26/75.
6. Rigged up and ran Cement Bond and Gamma-Ray Correlation log.
7. Pressure tested casing to 2500 psi for 10 minutes. Test OK.
8. Moved in and rigged up Completion Unit 6/9/75.
9. Perforated Point Lookout 1 shot/ft. from 5103-5144 ft. & 5150-5178 ft. C.O.M. 70 holes.
10. Sand water fraced perfs using 60,000# sand and 63,000 gallons of water. DIST. 3
11. Set 4-1/2" Bridge Plug at 4850 ft. R.K.B.
12. Perforated Cliff House 1 shot/ft. 4723-4781 ft. Total of 53 holes.
13. Sand water fraced perfs using 60,000# sand and 63,000 gallons of water.
14. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and bit. Drilled out bridge plug at 4850 ft. R.K.B. Cleaned out well to P.B.T.D. of 5340 ft. R.K.B.
15. Ran 143 joints of 2-1/16", 3.25%, I.J. Production tubing on one (1) 6 ft. perforated nipple. Tubing landed at 4715 ft. Gr.
16. Well completed 6/13/75.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
