

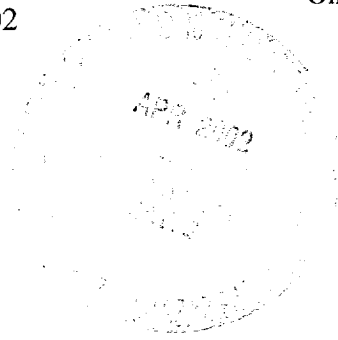

***Administrative Order NSL-4714***

 Dear Mr. Corcoran:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated March 13, 2002 (*application reference No. pKRV0-207457213*), which was received by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe on March 15, 2002; and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe and Aztec: all concerning Energen Resources Corporation's request to drill its proposed San Juan "32-5" Unit Well No. 110 (**API No. 30-039-26721**) at an off-pattern non-standard coal gas well location 155 feet from the South line and 65 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 22, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The S/2 of Section 22 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre lay-down gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool (**71629**).

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
