DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 892'. Plugged back depth 790'.

The proposed plugging program for this well is as follows:

Pump 100 sacks of cement down 7" casing to cover perforations from 718' to 744', spot 4 sack cement plug in top of 7" casing, cut off well head and cement 4" pipe marker in top of hole.

This report is to confirm verbal approval received to plug this well, November 28, 1956, from Mr. Jerry Long.
