El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard unit comprising the West Half (W/2) (or Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, NE/4 NW/4, NE/4 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4) of Section 30, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Heaton #2 Well is located 1659 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 30, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 323.40 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
- 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


