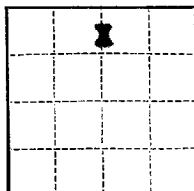

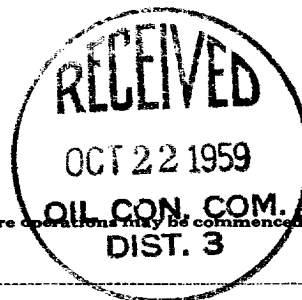

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Total depth 3210. 5-1/2" casing set at 3205' and cemented in 2-stages. First stage: cemented with 60 sacks 6% gel cement mixed with 2 pounds Tuf-Fing per sack. With stage collar set at 3216 cemented second stage with 350 sacks 6% gel cement mixed with 2 pounds Tuf-Fing per sack. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 2700 psi for 30 minutes with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 4-3/4" and resumed drilling to 3344'. Ran 4" liner set at 3336-3340 and slotted 3336-3334. Resumed completion operations.
