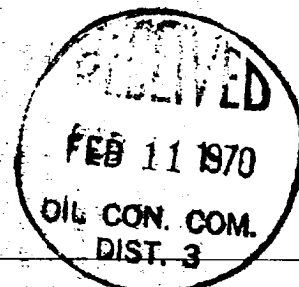

Instructions
