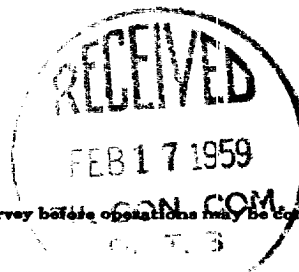

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Sand pumped hole cavings in 4-3/4" hole to 3650'. Moved in reverse drilling unit and drilled to 3690'. 4" CD Hydril FJ liner with 4 - 3/8" holes per foot was set in open hole below 3 1/2" casing at 3690'. (Not cemented) Ran logs. Sand-oil fraced with 8384 gal. crude oil and 13,300' sand thru perforations in liner from 3369' to 3690' (open hole). Avg. inj. rate of 36.4 bbls. per min. Now recovering lead oil.
