DETAILS OF WORK

The Ute Mtn. Tribal 2-29 #1 was spudded on December 10, 1957. Surface casing (8 5/8") was set at 261 ft. and cemented with 130 sacks cement. At the end of December operation was drilling ahead at 3369' using a 7 7/8" bit.
