Propose to: Set approximately 150' of 10 3/4" casing. Drill to an approximate total depth of 1,900' and set 7 5/8" intermediate casing. Drill with gas through Point Lookout formation and run 250' of 5 1/2" liner to total depth. Perforate Point Lookout. Sand-water frac with 1500 barrels water 60,000 lbs. sand. Install 2 3/8" tubing.

The proration unit assigned is the W/2, consisting of 320 acres.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

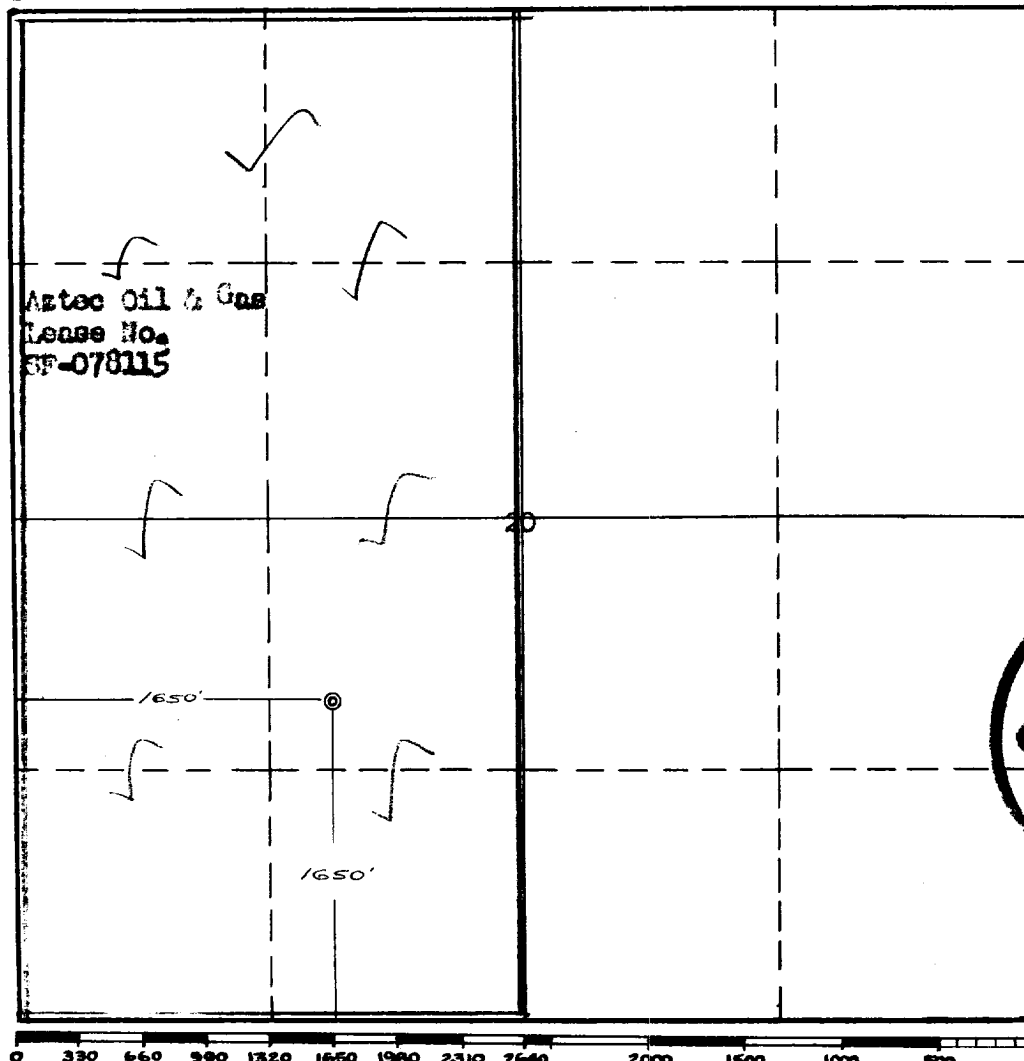
