Dear Mr. Arnold:

We would like to request tentative approval to dual-complete Aztec's Grenier No. 6 well, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

We propose to dually-complete this well in the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde formations. We propose to set casing, perforate and sand-water frac these two zones, install dual parallel tubing strings with an acceptable tubing anchor and separation packer at approximately 2800'. Proposed total depth 5200'.

The acreage dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs is the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, consisting of 160 acres. The W $\frac{1}{2}$, consisting of 320 acres, is dedicated to the Mesaverde.
