Enclosed is a deliverability re-test on the referenced well. This re-test was approved by a letter we received from you during the test conditioning period.

A packer leakage test was made on this well after deliverability testing was completed. It was conducted by flowing the tubing completion (Mesa-verde) for a period of one week with the casing completion (Pictured Cliffs) shut-in. The test was completed May 13, 1958. Test results are reflected in the following tabulation.
