DETAILS OF WORK

This well is perforated 1500'-1504' and 1505'-1506' in the Gallup Formation. The purpose is to convert the water injection as part of a secondary recovery program. A perforation will be made to separate the zones. Water will be injected there taking into the lower zone, and then the casing-tubing annulus into the upper zone.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

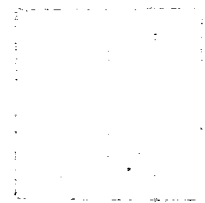
