If changes in the above plans become advisable we will notify you immediately.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (If recompletion give full details of proposed plan of work.) This well was originally completed in the Cliff House and Point Lookout with 3 1/2" casing set at 4100'. Due to water in Cliff House, we plan to plug back with cement plugs at 4075-4100' and 2700-2750'. We will attempt to cut and pull 3 1/2" from 2700' and then set whipstock and drill new hole from about 2700' to 4600' where 3 1/2" will be set. We plan to cement-frace the Point Lookout from 4600' to 4800' with about 9000 gallons.

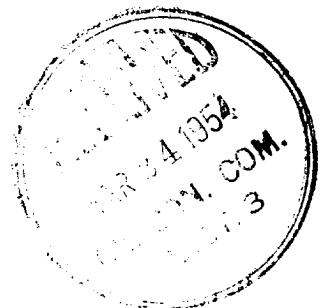
