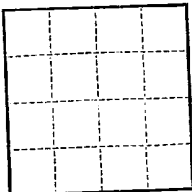

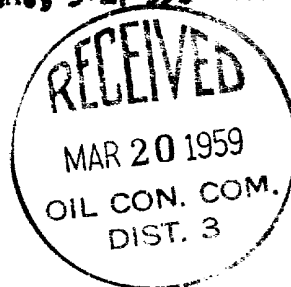

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled to a T.D. of 1180' Ran 45 joints 4-1/2" O.D. 9.5# J-55 casing = 1167.24'. Set at 1174.27' and cemented with 190 sacks regular mix Pozmix. Plug down 6:00 A.M., 3-16-59. Ran 4 centralizers. W.O.C. to 7:00 A.M., 3-17-59. Tested 4-1/2" casing with 1200" for 30 minutes, J.K.
