DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to:

1. Move in cable tool rig. Clean out 5 1/2" csg. to new P.B.T.D. of 2745 ft.
2. Perf. Gallup zone from 2683 to 2745 ft. and sand oil frac zone with 30,000# sand and 30,000 gallons oil.
3. Run tubing, pump and rods and place well back on production.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
