DETAILS OF WORK

TD 2753. Set 5 1/2" casing at 2753 with 75 sacks cement, and two stage cement collar at 2082 with 75 sacks cement. Drilled cement Plug 11-29-58. Tested for 2 hours with 500 lbs. pressure, pipe OK. Drilled to 2842. Ran logs - top of Lower Gallup (pay) 2780. Semi-oil fraced with 80% barrels oil and 40,000 lbs. sand BHP 800#, Treating Pressure 800#, Final Vacuum, I.R. 58 bpm. Landed 2 3/8" tubing at 2775, ran rods and pump. Recovered all load oil 12-6-58.
