2. Ran 82 jts 5 1/2", 15.5#, J-55 casing on Sept. 26, 1959. Pipe landed at 3672' B.D.F. Ran stage collar @ 1944. Cmt. first stage w/35 ax reg cmt w/2% gel.
3. Ran temperature survey on first stage on Sept. 27, 1959. Cmt. top @ 2365'.
4. Cement second stage thru D.V. tool w/40 ax reg w/2% gel on Sept. 28, 1959. Ran temp. survey on Sept. 29, 1959 on second stage. Cement top at 1545'.
5. Clean out to TD (2815') Natural completion.
6. Ran 85 jts. 2-3/8", 4.7#, J-55 tbg. on Sept. 30, 1959. Tubing landed at 2709'.
