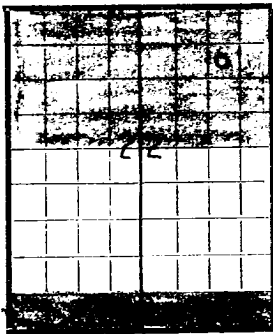

We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Rotary tools to approximately 4900 feet. Cable tools to base of Point Lookout Sand, approx. 5200 feet. Cable tools to set surface casing.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Blanket bond dated 9-25-50 in your files.
