DETAILS OF WORK

Propose To:

Set 300 feet of 8 5/8" surface casing and cement to surface.
Drill with rotary to approximate total depth of 7245 feet through the Dakota formation. Set 4 1/2" production casing at total depth and cement with 250 cu. Set two-stage cement collar approximately 100 feet below the Mesaverde formation and cement to cover both the Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs formations. Perforate and sand-water from Dakota formation. Run 2 3/8" tubing.

East one-half, Section 24, 30 acres dedicated to this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

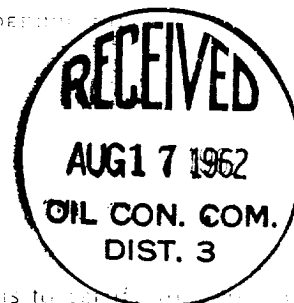
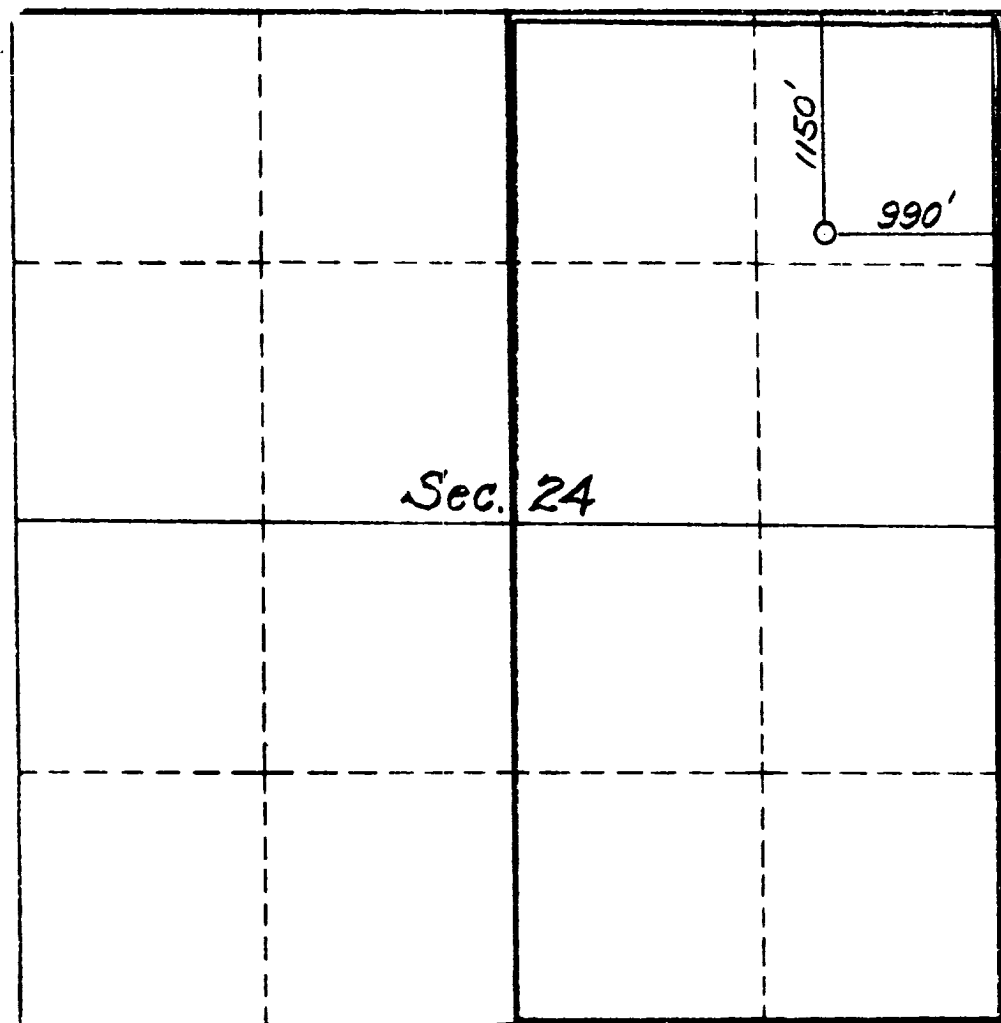
