Greenbrier Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Pool for its proposed Hedges #2 well. Such unit to consist of NE/4, N/2 SE/4, and SW/4 SE/4 of Section 23, and the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 24, all in Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

We believe the below listed facts substantiate approval:

1. Approval will not cause waste.
2. Correlative rights will be protected.
3. All lands encompassed by the application consist of one entire basic lease.
4. The proposed unit is identical to the non-standard proration unit established by Order R-230 for Mesaverde production.

6. The compatible Dakota proration unit was approved by Order R-1902.
