Dear Mr. Porter:

Greenbrier Oil Company hereby submits its Application in tripli-  
cate for an exception to Rule 5(a) of Order No. R-1670 and approval of a  
non-standard gas proration unit consisting of Section 24, NW/4 NW/4, and  
Section 23, NE/4, N/2 SE/4, SW/4 SE/4, T-31-N, R-12-W, NMPM, San Juan County,  
New Mexico. Please see Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

In support of this Application, Applicant respectfully states the  
following:

1. By order No. R-230 dated December 4, 1952 (Case No. 425), the  
Commission authorized the drilling of a well in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool  
on a drilling unit comprising the acreage described above. This well is  
known as the Greenbrier Oil Company No. 1 S. Hedges and is located in NE/4  
SE/4 of Section 23, T-31-N, R-12-W. The well was completed on December 26,  
1952, as a gas well and is still producing gas from the Mesaverde formation.

2. Applicant desires to drill a second well on the non-standard  
gas proration unit previously approved. The second well will be drilled to  
the Dakota formation and will be located in the NE/4 NE/4, Section 23, T-31-N,  
R-12-W.

3. All acreage surrounding Greenbrier Oil Company No. 1 Hedges  
unit is owned by Aztec Oil & Gas Company. The Commission approved a non-  
standard gas proration unit in the Basin Dakota Gas Pool by its Order  
R-1902 issued March 9, 1961, covering Aztec No. 5 East, which unit is

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contiguous to Greenbrier's acreage and is similar in shape. Aztec Oil & Gas Company has promised to formally approve this application upon receipt of a copy hereof.

4. Applicant's entire non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and does not exceed 5,280 feet in length or width. It is semi-proven acreage with Dakota production on the east and west sides.

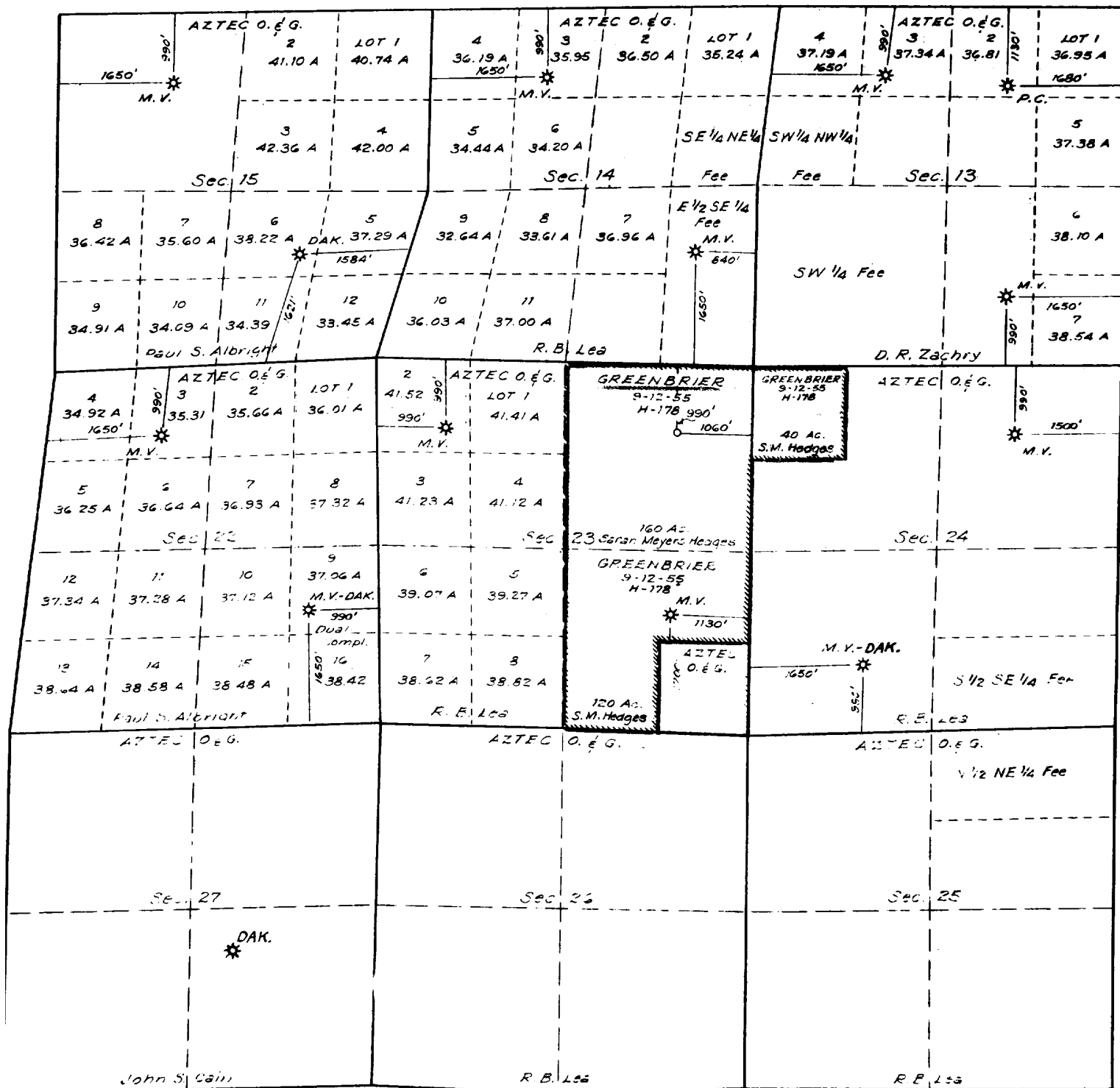
