We are requesting permission to drill a well at the above location to an approximate depth of 5140', and complete in the Point Lookout sand. Approximately 200' of 10-3/4", 32.75#, H-40 surface casing will be set and cemented to the surface. Approximately 4700' of 7", 23#, J-55 casing will be run and cemented in accordance with good operating practices, and approximately 550' of 5", 15#, liner will be set and cemented with good operating practices.

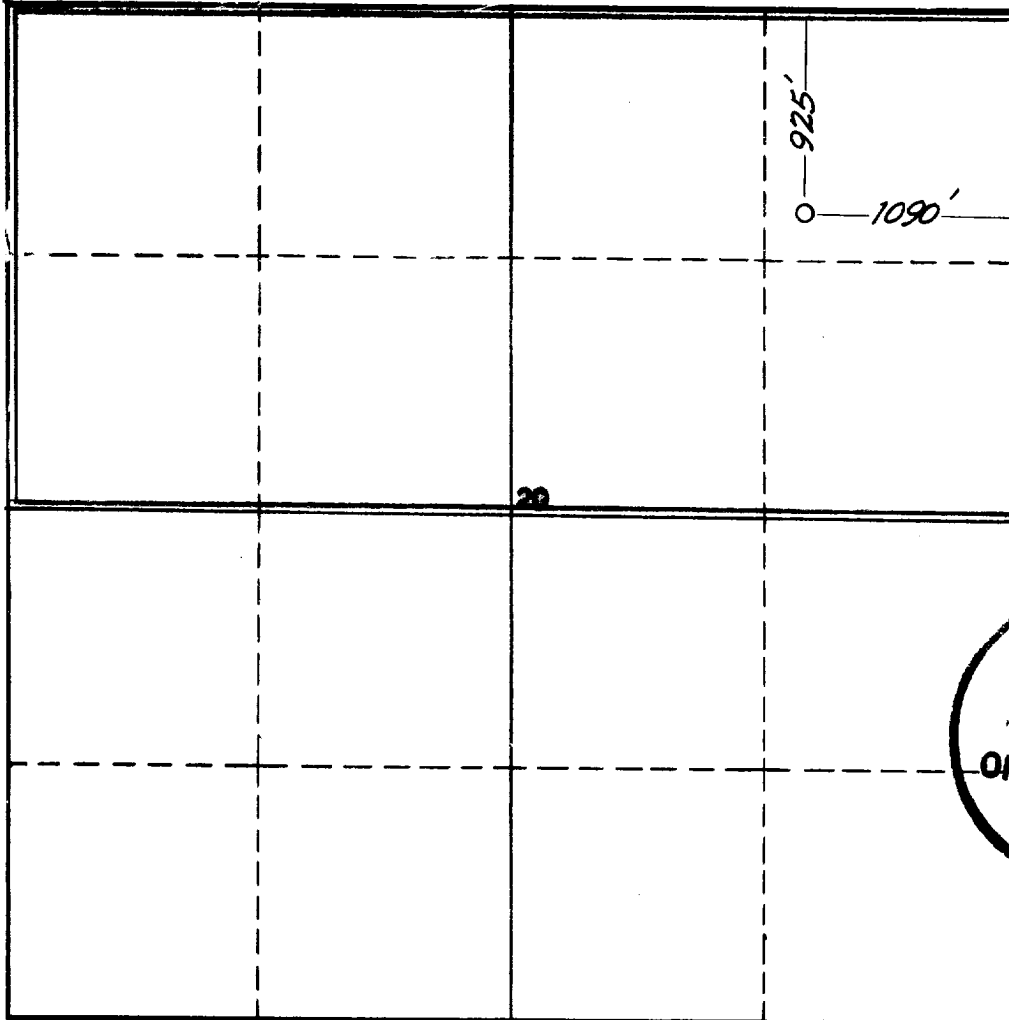
