The above well was plugged and abandoned as follows:

1. Set Baker 5-1/2", Cast Iron Cement Retainer at 2550 feet D.F. Cemented off Gallup perforations from 2626 to 2728 feet with 70 sack cement.
2. Filled 5-1/2" casing from 2550 ft. to 1480 ft. w/9.0#/gal. drilling mud.
3. Set 10 sack cement plug in 5-1/2" casing from 1400 ft. to 1480 ft.
4. Cut off 5-1/2" casing at lowest free point of 1350 ft. and pulled from hole.
5. Set 90 sack cement plug from 1150 ft. to 1350 ft., Set 50 sack cement plug across bottom of surface casing from 40 ft. to 90 ft. Set 10 sack cement plug in top of surface casing.
6. Erected regulation dry hole marker and cleaned location.
7. Well plugged and abandoned January 15, 1965.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
