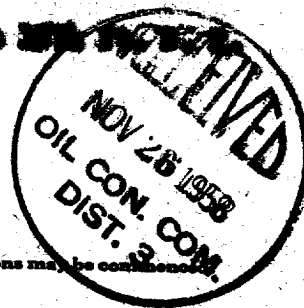
Well No. 2-37 is located 440 ft. from N line and 440 ft. from W line of sec. 17

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Run 24 joints 2 1/2", 4-24, 25-26 casing on October 21, 1958, landed at 2744 ft. D.F. Cemented with 75 sacks regular cement with 25 gal. Water stage collar set at 2744 ft.
2. Run temperature survey on October 21, 1958, top cement at 2744 ft.
3. Cemented second stage then Water stage collar at 2744' with 25 sacks regular cement with 25 gal. on October 21, 1958.
4. Run temperature survey on October 21, 1958, top of cement at 2744 ft.
